One of the most famous national parks in the United States, in the Sierra Nevada Mountains of the western state of California, is one of the most beautiful places in the country. Its name is Yosemite. Yosemite National Park is a place of extremes. It has high mountains and valleys formed by ancient ice that cut deep into the Earth millions of years ago. Water from high in the mountains falls in many places to the green valley far below. There are thirteen beautiful waterfalls in Yosemite Valley. One of these waterfalls, Yosemite Falls, is the fifth highest on Earth. There are clear lakes up in the mountains, quick-moving small rivers, and huge formations of rock. One huge rock is called Half Dome and it rises more than two thousand seven hundred meters into the air. Yosemite has a beautiful slow-moving river and large grassy areas where you can see wild animals. More than sixty kinds of animals live in the park. Deer are very common, you can see them almost everywhere and they are not really afraid of humans. You might even see a large black bear. You can also see two hundred different kinds of birds. In a place called the Mariposa Grove, visitors can see some of the **largest**, tallest and oldest living things on Earth. These are the giant sequoia trees. One of these trees is called grizzly giant and it is more than one thousand eight hundred years old. One tree is almost ninety meters tall. Another is more than ten meters around. The huge old trees can make you feel very, very small.
